

"Baby Lucky's worried in case Spike isn't here for his birthday," said Heart Throb. "He'll be back," laughed Majesty.




"Of course he will," agreed Heart Throb.

"What for?" asked Baby Lucky. "Greatgrandfather sent a present for Pony Land," explained Spike. "It's outside."




"Where abouts outside?" shouted Baby Lucky. "I love presents." "It's by the nursery," said Spike. "Come on, everyone."


"I didn't make it big!" said Baby Lucky.


"Or pegasus magic," laughed Locket, and she touched the key on Spike's card. The key moved towards the door...

When Megan and Sundance go riding together they make a fine pair.


Megan likes to wear her favourite green dungarees.

"So your message to me is to eat special honey?" laughed Locket.


"That's right," replied Iris. "My friend Pandora will give you some. Pandora's name means many gifts, the honey is just one gift."

You see, it's a My Little Pony Bedroom so I'm always thinking about





"That's right, I do," said Sunbeam. "I've arranged a party for tonight." "Could I perform a dance?" asked Baby Half Note.




"She's very good," said Spike, "she danced for us earlier." "I'll dance now," laughed Baby Half Note, "I love dancing!"
